Bradwood Avenue (10th Street West to 7th Street West)

Roadway

The road was originally constructed in 1970 according to available records. This included an approximate pavement width of 32 feet. Staff recommendation is to reconstruct the roadway to 37 feet wide with curb and gutter, and spot repair the sidewalk. While staff would normally recommend a narrower roadway given the residential nature of the neighborhood, we're aware of the frequent use of the road for parking during various school-related functions.

Utilities

The underlying water and sewer mains are at an age where replacement is warranted. This will include replacement of the water and sewer services to the boulevard, and will likely require limited removal and replacement of sidewalk at each connection.

Lake Road (East of Union Pacific Railroad Driveway to Park Road)

Roadway

The segment of roadway from east of the Union Pacific Railroad driveway to Park Road was last repaved in two sections in 1972 and 1976 according to available records. The proposed scope of work includes removing and replacing the asphalt pavement and enhancing the shoulders through the curves.
