Describe Action to be Taken: (Shall be necessary and expedient for the health, safety and welfare of the City) Governor Evers' Safer at Home Order is currently in effect until May 26, 2020 and the Badger Bounce Back Plan will be implemented as specific metrics are met. This leaves much uncertainty with respect to planning for public events in late May and June when we traditionally hold our community celebration, Cinder City Days, and begin our music series in River Prairie Park. To address that uncertainty this emergency order would prohibit large gatherings organized or permitted by the City through June 30, 2020.
