Position Summary

Under the supervision of the Recreation Manager or Recreation Supervisor, the Fish House Recreation Center Attendant will be responsible for conducting and actively being involved with activities that take place at the Fish House Recreation Center. The Fish House Recreation Center is open to children in Altoona who are in kindergarten to eighth grade. The center is open Monday-Friday during summer months from 1:00-4:00pm.

Work Tasks

The following duties are normal for this position. The duties listed are not to be construed as all-inclusive. Other duties may be required and assigned.

- Responsible for all activities during assigned hours
- Actively be involved with the children that come to the Fish House Recreation Center
- Responsible for the Fish House Recreation Center facility and all equipment belonging to the Parks & Recreation Department
- Check equipment and games; pull anything that is not safe. Notify the Parks & Recreation Office of damaged equipment or equipment that needs to be replaced
- Check bathrooms, clean and restock (If supplies are needed to restock let the Parks & Recreation Office know)
- Organize activities for children to be involved in
- Wipe up spills and sweep entire building daily
- Take attendance and make sure all equipment is returned daily
- All doors and windows must be locked and all faucets and electrical power is turned off before leaving the Recreation Center
- Be punctual and reliable (arrive 15mins. prior to the start time)
- Must be able to follow all policies and procedures of the department as outlined in the Employee Handbook

Working Conditions

- Work is completed mostly outdoors.
- Outdoor work may be in a variety of environmental extremes such as heat, cold, rain, wind, noise, fumes and dust.
- Employees may be required to wear masks and abide by other recommended or required protocols to aid in reducing the spread of disease.

Education

- High school student; or
- College student

Experience

Some previous experience as an employee with a demonstrated history of being reliable and dependable is expected.

Licenses and Certificates

- If under 16 years of age a work permit is required; and,
- CPR/First Aid Certification, preferred.
