- Helps umpires (collect homerun balls over fence or steps in and umpires when sub is unavailable)
- Hand out and collect umpire cards before/after each game
- Assist Concession Stand worker if needed
- Pick up trash on grounds continuously
- Close park by turning off all park field lights, locking light switch boxes and shutting gate
- Attend all required staff meetings and trainings
- Be punctual and reliable (arrive 15mins. Prior to the start time)
- Follow all policies and procedures of the department as outline in the Employee Handbook

- Work is completed mostly outdoors.
- Outdoor work may be in a variety of environmental extremes such as heat, cold, rain, wind, noise, fumes and dust.
